

Outdoor Activities

Hot Springs National Park

Hot Springs National Park, just a three-hour drive south of Jonesboro, makes for an ideal weekend getaway for outdoorspeople, shoppers, and spa enthusiasts.

• Lake Frierson State Park

Within 10 miles of Jonesboro, this outdoor destination offers picnic and camping sites and cabins, as well as trails for hikers, mountain bikers and ATV riders. Anglers can enjoy year-round crapple, catfish, bream and bass fishing.

Craighead Forest Park

This scenic park is the spot for disc golf, sports, birding, camping and trail-running along with kayaking and fishing on Craighead Forest Lake.

Arts, Entertainment and Community

• Fowler Center

Art, music, performances and events, camps and conferences, academic presentations, workshops, and game nights can be found at the multipurpose Fowler Center.

Bradbury Art Museum

Admission to this contemporary art space on A-State's campus is always free for students and the community.

• First National Bank Arena

This is where you can catch Red Wolves basketball games, A-State commencement ceremonies and other large events along with concerts and monster truck shows.



GETTING A-ROUND A-STATE

- Driving Directions
 - Follow this **link** to find your way to campus from any direction.
- From U.S. Highway 49/Red Wolf Boulevard to Campus: U.S. Highway 49 is called Red Wolf Boulevard on and near the A-State campus. If you are approaching from the south on U.S. Highway 49 (for example, coming from Memphis or Little Rock via Interstate 555), turn left (west) at the traffic signal at Red Wolf Boulevard and Aggie Road. If you are coming from the north (from St. Louis, for example), it will be a right turn to go west at the signal. Continue on Aggie Road through the four-way stop. Visitor parking in lot N-8 is located on the right, just past Greek Village. The Welcome Center is located west of parking lot N-8 at 2400 Aggie Road, Jonesboro, AR.











TRANSPORTATION

Jonesboro Economical Transportation

Jonesboro Economical Transportation (JET) offers public transportation for the Jonesboro community. <u>Find</u> route maps and schedules here.

Jonesboro Municipal Airport

Southern Airways Express provides an average of three round-trip flights per day to and from St. Louis, Missouri (STL) and Nashville, Tennessee (BNA) airports where you can catch connecting flights.

Memphis International Airport (MEM)

Located about 80 miles southeast of Jonesboro via I-55, Memphis International Airport offers direct flights to more than 30 destinations in the United States—as well as Cancun, Mexico.
